


## WORKERS' COMPENSATION ACT 1951

### DECLARATION

**WHEREAS** by a letter dated 6 June 1994 the Presbyterian Church of Australia has requested the Minister to declare the following classes of persons ie, ministers of religion, ordained minister, ordained assistant minister, assistant minister (not ordained) other than home missionary, home missionary, deaconess employed by the Presbyterian Church of Australia in the Australian Capital Territory to be workers for the purposes of *ACT Workers' Compensation Act 1951*.

**NOW THEREFORE** under Section 6A(1) of the *ACT Workers' Compensation Act 1951* I declare that each person employed in the Australian Capital Territory as a minister of religion, ordained minister, ordained assistant minister, assistant minister (not ordained) other than home missionary, home missionary and deaconess by the Presbyterian Church of Australia in the Australian Capital Territory and whose employment is that of a religious worker or pastoral duties is a worker for the purposes of the Act.
