

**ACT PLANNING AUTHORITY**

**DRAFT VARIATION NO.26 TO THE TERRITORY PLAN**

**HERITAGE PLACES REGISTER**

The ACT Planning Authority is inviting comment on a draft Variation No.26 to the Territory Plan which proposes to incorporate the Interim Heritage Places Register into the Territory plan.

On 1 December 1993 the Heritage Council of the ACT entered the following places in an Interim Heritage Places Register, in accordance with the provisions of section 60 of the Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991:

- . Canberra Croquet Club House and Lawns
- . City Hill
- . Deasland Homestead and Dairy
- . Ginninderra Blacksmith's Workshop
- . Ginninderra Police Station and Grounds
- . Aboriginal Place PH12
- . Aboriginal Place PH13
- . Sir Harold and Lady White's Garden
- . Surveyor's Hut
- . "The Valley"
- . Woolshed Creek Fossil Site and Narrabundah Ashstone Locality.

On the same date the Heritage Council notified the interim registration of the above places by notice published in Special Gazette S248.

The ACT Planning Authority has considered the Interim Heritage Places Register and agrees with all the proposals set out therein. The Authority therefore has prepared a draft Variation to the Territory Plan, in accordance with the requirements of section 17 of the Land Act, in order that the places specified in the Variation may be entered into the Heritage Places Register at Appendix V of the Territory Plan.

Copies of the draft Variation:

- . may be inspected at libraries of the ACT Government Library Service at Belconnen, Civic, Dickson, Erindale, Griffith, Kippax, Tuggeranong and Woden during normal opening hours; and
- . may be inspected at, or obtained free of charge from, the Shopfront at John Overall Offices, 220 Northbourne Avenue, Braddon, during normal office hours from Monday 29 August 1994 to Monday 19 September 1994.

This draft Variation is to have interim effect under the provision of section 9 of the Act for the "defined period".
