FIRE BRIGADE (ADMINISTRATION) ACT 1974

ESTABLISHMENT OF A JOINT SELECTION COMMITTEE

A Joint Selection Committee has been established under section 29B of the *Fire Brigade (Administration) Act 1974* to advise the Fire Commissioner in relation to the promotion of members of the Fire Brigade to the rank of District Officer.

To be eligible for promotion to the rank of District Officer a member must have completed at least two years service as a Station Officer and have passed the qualifying examination for promotion to the rank of District Officer.

Eligible members are invited to apply for promotion and should obtain a copy of Staff Minute 1993/94-97 from the Personnel Section at ACT Emergency Management Headquarters, 123 Carruthers Street, Curtin.

Promotions made under section 29B of the Act are not subject to appeal.
