#### MILK AUTHORITY ACT 1971

The Milk Authority of the Australian Capital Territory, in pursuance of Section 16A of the Milk Authority Act 1971, hereby fixes and declares

1. This notice takes effect on Friday 25 October 1996
2. The Gazette notice published in ACT Gazette Special Gazette dated 15 August 1996 is hereby amended
3. Pursuant to Section 16A(1) of the Milk Authority Act 1971

- (a) The maximum price at which packaged milk (pasteurised or pasteurised and homogenised, including skim milk and modified milk and flavoured milk as specified) may be sold by processors to distributors is fixed at and declared to be
