DRAFT VARIATION NO.83 TO THE TERRITORY PLAN - GROUP CENTRES - PROVISION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND MINOR CORRECTIONS

The Planning and Land Management Group of the Department of Urban Services has undertaken a review of the Group Centres policies in the Territory Plan, which has revealed an inconsistency with the treatment of Personal services across the various categories of Group Centres, as well as a number of typographical errors.

Draft Variation No 83 to the Territory Plan has resulted from this review and proposes to

- amend the commercial policies in the Territory Plan Written Statement to expand the provision for Personal services at the Dickson and Manuka Group Centres, and
- correct a number of typographical errors in the Dickson and Manuka Group Centres policies

Copies of the draft Variation to the Territory Plan
