## Draft Variation No. 91 to the Territory Plan Signs Policies

The Planning and Land Management Group (PALM) of the Department of Urban Services (incorporating the ACT Planning Authority) is proposing a draft Variation to the Territory Plan which, if adopted, would

recognise the important role of signage,

- recognise the visual impact of signage and ensure that it is appropriate and compatible with local amenity;
- clarify those aspects of the current policy which have caused interpretation problems and conflicts for both the approval authority and applicants, and,
- Introduce a form of performance based controls which allow a focus on outcomes rather than prescriptive controls

This draft Variation is to have interim effect under the provision of section 9 of the Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991 for the "defined period"
