The Tribunal can agree with, change or reject to the original decision, substitute its own decision or send the matter back to the decision maker for reconsideration in accordance with Tribunal recommendations.

How to apply to the ACT Administrative Appeals Tribunal – Write within 28 days explaining the details of the decision and the reasons for asking for a review.

Cost – To lodge an application there is a fee of \$134.00. You may apply to have the fee waived on the grounds of hardship. No fee is payable if you are receiving legal assistance.
