**DRAFT VARIATION NO. 63 TO THE TERRITORY PLAN FOR PROPOSED
AMENDMENTS - HOME OCCUPATIONS AND HOME BUSINESS PROVISIONS**

The Planning and Land Management Group (PALM) of the Department of Urban Services (incorporating the ACT Planning Authority) is proposing a draft Variation to the Territory Plan which, if adopted, would amend some of the current provisions relating to the control and definition of *Home occupation* and *Home business*. The changes are required to clarify the original policy intention and to correct omissions and unintended inconsistencies between the two categories of use, which have arisen in practice.

This draft Variation is to have interim effect under the provision of section 9 of the *Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991* for the "defined period"
