DECLARATION OF ENDEMIC STOCK DISEASE QUARANTINE AREA

DECLARATION NO. 1 OF 1998

Under Subsection 23(1) of the Animal Diseases Act 1993, I declare that the attached diagram depicting an area of land to be an endemic stock diseases quarantine area.

The endemic disease is Ovine Johne's Disease.

The species that this declaration relates to are sheep, goats and deer but excludes fallow deer.

The area depicted in the attached diagram is Tuggeranong District Block 1512.

The owner or manager of the property shall not move any sheep, goats or deer now on the property or that may at any time be on the property, off the property except in accordance with the written consent (containing conditions for movement) of an inspector designated under the Animal Diseases Act 1993.
