### WORKERS' COMPENSATION ACT 1951

#### DECLARATION

**WHEREAS** by a letter dated 9 October 1998, a person acting on behalf of the Catholic Archdiocese of Canberra and Goulburn has requested that a Permanent Deacon employed by the Catholic Archdiocese of Canberra and Goulburn to be declared workers' for the purposes of the *Workers' Compensation Act 1951*.

**NOW THEREFORE** under subsection 6A (1) of the ACT *Workers' Compensation Act 1951*, I declare that each person employed in the Australian Capital Territory by the Catholic Archdiocese of Canberra and Goulburn as a Permanent Deacon, and whose employment is that of a religious nature not being the full range of duties performed by an ordained Priest, is a worker for the purposes of the Act.
