## **Direction to Notify an interim Heritage Place Register for Guardian House (Woden Valley) 2002**

**Notifiable Instrument NI 2002 - 403**

made under the

***Land (Planning and Environment Act) 1991* section 60 (Public Notification)**

I, Dr Sandy Blair notify an interim Heritage Place Register for Guardian House, Woden Valley (Block 61, Section 8, Phillip). Copies of the interim register are available for public inspection at the Environment Information Centre, Level 2, Macarthur House, 12 Wattle Street, Lyneham or at ACT Government Shopfronts and Public Libraries.

### **EFFECT OF INCLUSION IN AN INTERIM REGISTER**

Pursuant to section 55 of the Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991, during the defined period an interim Heritage Places Register has effect as if it were the Heritage Places Register. The Territory, the Executive, a Minister, or a Territory authority shall not do any act, or approve the doing of any act, which would be inconsistent with the Heritage Places Register.

The 'defined period' means the period beginning on the day the interim heritage places register is notified (other than in a newspaper) as required by section 60 (Public notification) and ending at the end of the earlier of—

- (a) the day before the heritage register prepared in consideration of the interim register commences under section 29 (6) (Consideration of plan variation by Legislative Assembly) or section 30A (5) (Partial rejection of plan variation by Legislative Assembly); or
- (b) three years from the date of this notification.

## **REVIEW OF DECISION**

Pursuant to section 282A(5) of the Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991, a person whose interests in relation to land are affected by the decision may apply to the Administrative Appeals Tribunal (AAT) for a review of the above decision of the Heritage Council to include a provision, in respect of a place listed above, in an interim Heritage Places Register.
