1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Road Transport (Alcohol and Drugs) Breath Analysing Instrument Approval 2004 (No 1).

2 Details of instrument

In pursuance of section 5(1) of the Road Transport (Alcohol and Drugs) Act 1977, I Bill Wood, Minister for Urban Services in the Australian Capital Territory, am of the opinion that-

- (a) the Drager Alcotest 7110 MKV Breath Analysing instrument is designed and constructed for the purpose of analysing the concentration of alcohol present in a sample of person's breath and is capable of recording that concentration in grams per 100 millilitres of blood; and
- (b) is suitable for use in analyses under section 5 (2) of the Road Transport (Alcohol and Drugs) Act 1977.

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

4 Revocation

This instrument revokes NI2002-68 Road Transport (Alcohol and Drugs) - Notice of Approval of Breath Analysing Instrument, dated 28 February 2002.
