Land (Planning and Environment) (Interim Heritage Places Register) Revision 2004 (No 1)*

Notifiable Instrument NI 2004 - 28

made under the

Land (Planning and Environment Act) 1991 section 62 (Revision of interim register)

I, Dr Sandy Blair revoke NI 172 of 2003 notified on the ACT Legislation Register on 24 May 2003 and notify a revised interim Heritage Place Register for 113 Schlich Street (Block 10 Section 26 Yarralumla) pursuant to the decision of the ACT Administrative Appeals Tribunal (Land and Planning Division) AT 03/52 and AT 03/55 of 18 December 2003.

Copies of the revised interim register are available for public inspection at the Environment Information Centre, Level 2, Macarthur House, 12 Wattle Street, Lyneham or at ACT Government Shopfronts and Public Libraries.

EFFECT OF INCLUSION IN AN INTERIM REGISTER

Pursuant to section 55 of the Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991, during the defined period an interim Heritage Places Register has effect as if it were the Heritage Places Register. The Territory, the Executive, a Minister, or a Territory authority shall not do any act, or approve the doing of any act, which would be inconsistent with the Heritage Places Register.

The 'defined period' means the period commencing on the date the interim Register is notified in the Gazette under section 60 and terminating at the expiration of – (a) the day before the date a Heritage Places Register prepared in consideration of the interim Register comes into effect under section 30; or (b) three years from the date this notice is notified on the ACT Legislation Register.
