## 1 Name of Instrument

This instrument is the Hotel School (Fees) Determination 2004 (No 1).

Pursuant to Section 30 of the *Hotel School Act 1996*, the Board of Management of the Australian International Hotel School (“School”) determines that the fees as set out in Schedule 1 are payable from 1 January 2007, by students enrolled in the Bachelor of Business (Hotel Management) Degree, or equivalent course, conducted by the School.

## 2 Commencement

This instrument commences 17 September 2004.

## **Schedule 1 to Hotel School (Fees) Determination 2004 (No 1)**

The tuition fees are based on a cost per academic subject (including the management externship) required to complete the qualification.

### **National Students**

The following are eligible for national student fees:

- Australian Citizens
- Permanent residents of Australia
- New Zealand Citizens (\*New Zealand Citizens will be required to also pay Overseas Health Cover costs, as determined by the Australian Government).

The fees for enrolled National Students will from 1 January 2007 be \$1,774 per academic subject.

### **International Students**

International students are those students who do not meet the definition of a National Student.

The fees for enrolled International Students will from 1 January 2007 be \$1,991 per academic subject.

International students will also be required to pay overseas health cover costs as determined by the Australian Government.

### **Service Charges**

The Board may also apply service charges for materials and services provided to students.

### **Payment Arrangements**

All students have the choice of four payment plans.
