Changes to Territory Plan Map for Narrabundah, and Minor Amendments to Residential and Community Facility Land Use Policies and Part D Definition of Terms

Notifiable instrument NI2005—258

made under the

Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991, section 19(1) (Public Consultation - Notification)

Draft Variation No.262 to the Territory Plan has been prepared by the ACT Planning and Land Authority in accordance with section 19 of the *Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991* (the Act).

The draft plan Variation proposes to reduce the number of sections within Narrabundah included within the Residential A10 Area Specific Policy. It also proposes to extend the interim effect of draft Variation No.229 – Supportive Housing, particularly in relation to unit titling within Community Facility Land Use Policies.

Copies of written comments received, and any response from the National Capital Authority, will be made available for public inspection at the ACT Planning and Land Authority Customer Service Centre, 16 Challis Street, Dickson, during normal office hours for a period of 15 business days after the closing date for comments.

Section 9 of the Act applies to the draft variation, except for the provisions relating to Supportive Housing in a Community Facility Land Use Policy which have interim effect for 12 months or until draft Variation No.229 commences, whichever is shorter.

Those parts of the draft variation that are not specifically excluded from this have interim effect for a maximum period of 1 year commencing on 15 July 2005 and ending on 14 July 2006. During this period, or a period commencing on 15 July 2005 and terminating at the expiration of the day before:

- the date the draft variation comes into effect;
- the date the corresponding plan variation is rejected by the Legislative Assembly; or
- the date the draft variation, or the corresponding plan variation, is withdrawn under section 22(1)(c), section 27(a) or section 30A(3)(b) of the Act;

whichever is shorter, the Territory, the Executive, the Minister or a Territory Authority shall not do any act, or approve the doing of any act that –

- (a) would be inconsistent with the Territory Plan, if it were varied in accordance with the draft variation; or
- (b) is inconsistent with the Territory Plan.
