

# Road Transport (Alcohol and Drugs) Breath Screening Device Approval 2005 (No 1)

**Notifiable instrument NI2005–470**

Made under the

**Road Transport (Alcohol and Drugs) Act 1977 (s5) Approval of Instruments**

**1 Name of instrument**

This instrument is the Road Transport (Alcohol and Drugs) Breath Screening Device Approval 2005 (No 1).

**2 Commencement**

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

**3 Opinion**

I am of the opinion that the devices referred to in paragraph 4 are:

(a) breath screening devices that have been designed and made for the purpose of indicating, when a sample of the breath of a person is exhaled into the device, whether alcohol is present in the blood of the person and, if so, of giving an indication of the concentration of alcohol in the blood of the person, and

(b) breath screening devices that are suitable devices for use in tests under part 2 of the Act.

**4 Approval**

The following screening devices are approved under Section 5(2) of the Road Transport (Alcohol and Drugs) Act 1977:

- the lion alcolmeter SD-400 breath screening device, and
- the Alcolizer LE breath screening device.

**5 Revocation**

This instrument revokes NI2000-1 Road Transport (Alcohol and Drugs) Act 1977 Notice of Approval of Screening Device, dated 25 February 2000.
