Litter Act 2004, s 14 (Appointment of Authorised People)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Litter (Authorised People – Environment Protection and Heritage) Appointment 2008 (No 1).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

3 Appointment of authorised people

I appoint the people who from time to time occupy the public service positions listed in column 2 of the Schedule as authorised people.

Note 1 *The Legislation Act 2001* defines ‘occupy’, in relation to a position, to include hold the position, act in the position or exercise functions of the position.

Note 2 Section 14 of the *Litter Act 2004* requires authorised people to be public servants. The *Legislation Act 2001* defines ‘public servant’ to mean a person employed in the Australian Capital Territory Public Service.
