

# Lakes (Delegate and Inspectors – Environment Protection and Heritage) Appointment 2008 (No 1)

*Lakes Act 1976*, s 6 (Delegate for Lakes), s 7 (Inspectors)

## 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Lakes (Delegate and Inspectors – Environment Protection and Heritage) Appointment 2008 (No 1)

## 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

## 3 Delegate for Lakes

I appoint the person from time to time occupying the public service position listed in table 1 column 2 of the schedule as delegate for Lakes.

## 4 Appointment of Inspectors

I appoint the people who from time to time occupy the public service positions listed in table 2 column 2 of the Schedule as inspectors.

*Note 1* The *Legislation Act 2001* defines ‘occupy’, in relation to a position, to include hold the position, act in the position or exercise functions of the position.

*Note 2* Section 7(1) of the *Lakes Act 1976* requires inspectors to be public servants. The *Legislation Act 2001* defines ‘public servant’ to mean a person employed in the Australian Capital Territory Public Service.

*Note 3* Section 7(2) of the *Lakes Act 1976* states that the delegate for lakes and police officers are also inspectors
