## 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Trespass on Territory Land (Inspectors – Environment Protection and Heritage) Appointment 2008 (No 1)

## 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

## 3 Appointment of inspectors

I appoint the people who from time to time occupy the public service positions listed in column 2 of the Schedule as inspectors.

*Note 1* The *Legislation Act 2001* defines ‘occupy’, in relation to a position, to include hold the position, act in the position or exercise functions of the position.

*Note 2* Section 3A of the *Trespass on Territory Land Act 1932* requires inspectors to be public servants. The *Legislation Act 2001* defines ‘public servant’ to mean a person employed in the Australian Capital Territory Public Service.
