Clinical Waste Act 1990, s 7 (Clinical Waste Controller), s 9 (Inspectors)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Clinical Waste (Controller and Inspectors) Appointment 2008 (No 1).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification.

3 Appointment of clinical waste controller

I appoint the person who from time to time occupies the public service position listed in column 2 of table 1 of the schedule to be the clinical waste controller.

Note The Legislation Act 2001 defines 'occupy', in relation to a position, to include hold the position, act in the position or exercise functions of the position.

4 Appointment of acting clinical waste controller

I appoint the person who from time to time occupies the public service position listed in column 2 of table 2 of the schedule to act as the clinical waste controller when:

- (a) there is no person occupying the public service position described in section 3 above;
- (b) the person occupying that position is ill or on leave;
- (c) the person occupying that position is acting in another position; or
- (d) the person occupying that position is otherwise unavailable.
- Note 1 The power to appoint includes the power to make an acting appointment (see s 209 of the Legislation Act 2001).
- Note 2 If the person acting as the controller does so because the position of the controller is vacant, they may not act for more than 1 year after the position became vacant (see section 221 of the *Legislation Act 2001*).

5 Appointment of inspectors

I appoint the people who from time to time occupy the public service positions listed in column 2 of table 3 of the schedule as inspectors.

- Note 1 The Legislation Act 2001 defines 'occupy', in relation to a position, to include hold the position, act in the position or exercise functions of the position.
- Note 2 Section 9 of the Clinical Waste Act 1990 requires inspectors to be public servants. The Legislation Act 2001 defines 'public servant' to mean a person employed in the Australian Capital Territory Public Service.

6 Revocation of previous appointments

All previous instruments of appointment made under section 7 or section 9 of the Act are revoked.
