

# Children and Young People (Childcare Service Licence) Temporary Standards Exemption 2009 (No 2)\*

**Children and Young People Act 2008 Section 749 (2) Childcare licence – childcare service standards**

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## 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Children and Young People (Childcare Service Licence) Temporary Standards Exemption 2009 (No 2)*.

## 2 Purpose of this Instrument

This instrument is to issue a *Temporary Standards Exemption* as specified in Section 749 (2) of the *Children and Young People Act 2008*.

## 3 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

## 4 Expiry

This instrument expires six (6) months after the day it commences.

## 6 Temporary Standard Exemption Standard

Woden Community Services Incorporated is exempt from complying with *Children and Young People (ACT Childcare Services) Standards 2009 (No 1)*

### Standard 3.5

Persons working in second and subsequent qualified positions at the service must be filled with an adult holding one of the following criteria;

- a) any qualification detailed in *Core Standard 1.47* or *School Age Car Specific Standard 3.3*;
- b) studying towards a diploma or degree in a relevant field and has two years experience working in school age care;
- c) holds a Certificate IV in one of the following courses;
  - i. Children's Services;
  - ii. Out of school hours care;
  - iii. Lifestyle and leisure; or
- d) recognised overseas equivalent of the above qualifications.

## 7 Explanation and Additional Conditions

Curtin School Age Care is licensed for 66 places and employs a qualified coordinator. The *Children and Young People (ACT Childcare Services) Standards 2009 (No 1)* introduced on 27 February 2009 requires a qualified staff member for every thirty three (or part thereof) children. The proprietor, Woden Community Services Incorporated has applied for a *Temporary Standards Exemption* to this requirement whilst staff complete training towards the required qualification.
