SCHEDULE 1

Conditions applicable to approval of IMMEDIATE ASSISTANTS Pty Ltd to provide ambulance services in the ACT.

- 1. Immediate Assistants Pty Ltd may only provide emergency medical treatment within a defined precinct at static events within the ACT.
- 2. Immediate Assistants Pty Ltd must not provide emergency medical treatment at an event in the ACT unless the Emergency Services Commissioner has agreed in writing. The Emergency Services Commissioner's agreement must specify the boundaries of the event.
- 3. Immediate Assistants Pty Ltd must not transport any person outside the boundaries of the event specified by the Emergency Services Commissioner.
- 4. This approval only approves staff nominated in Immediate Assistants Pty Ltd original application. Any additional staff must be agreed by the Emergency Services Commissioner after review of their qualifications.
- 5. Immediate Assistants Pty Ltd must provide copies of any updated or renewed insurance documentation, or clinical or pharmaceutical management guidelines, to the Emergency Services Commissioner.
