<b>Clause 7</b> – Determine that an organisation is eligible for assistance	SOGA; SOGB; SOGC
<b>Clause 8</b> – exercise discretion to provide assistance to an eligible organisation	SOGA; SOGB
<b>Clause 9</b> – Decide to withdraw assistance (subject to the requirements of the <i>Residential Tenancies Act 1997</i> , as applicable)	SOGA; SOGB
<b>Clause 10</b> – ask an organisation to provide further information in relation to an application for assistance	SOGA; SOGB; SOGC; ASO6
<b>Clause 11</b> – make an offer of assistance conditional upon the eligible organisation entering into an approved agreement; decide to withdraw assistance if an agreement is not entered into	SOGA; SOGB
<b>Clause 12</b> – following a written request by an organisation, arrange for the reconsideration of a decision not to provide assistance; ensure that the reconsideration of a decision is undertaken by an officer other than the original decision-maker	(Deputy Chief Executive; Executive Director; Director Housing ACT; Director Asset Management only)
