St Monica's Out of School Hours Care operated by Trustees of the Roman Catholic Church for the Archdiocese of Canberra and Goulburn is exempt from complying with *Children and Young People (ACT Childcare Services)* Standards 2009 (No 1) –

Standard 3.4

The position of the service or camp director / coordinator must be filled by an adult who has attained the age of 21 years, and who holds one of the qualifications listed in Standard 3.3

7 Explanation and Additional Conditions

The service will operate with the support of an experienced staff member at times when the qualified Director is absent from the service. Child staff ratios will be maintained at all times.
