

Medicines, Poisons and Therapeutic Goods (Non standard labelling) Approval 2010 (No 1)

Notifiable instrument NI2010–709

made under the

Medicines, Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act, s 193 (Approval of non-standard packaging and labelling)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Medicines, Poisons and Therapeutic Goods (Non standard labelling) Approval 2010 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

3 Approval

I approve the supply of Chlorsig 0.5% chloramphenicol 5mg/ml eye drops bottle AUST R19661 and Chlorsig 1% chloramphenicol 10mg/g eye ointment tube AUST R 19962 with current schedule 4 labels.

4 Duration of approval

This approval is until the manufacture with the new schedule 3 labels can occur or until 31st March 2011, whichever occurs earliest.

This is a period of no more than 12 months from the date of the National Drugs and Poisons Scheduling Committee rescheduling decision effective 1st May 2010 in accordance with s13A of the Standard for the Uniform Scheduling of Medicines and Poisons.
