1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Confiscation of Criminal Assets (Distribution of Surplus Funds) Approval 2011*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after it is notified.

3 Distributable funds available

In accordance with section 134 of the *Confiscation of Criminal Assets Act 2003*, I decide that \$27,000.00 is the amount of distributable funds available for payment from the Confiscated Assets Trust Fund during the 2010/2011 financial year.

4 Use of funds available

In accordance with section 134 of the *Confiscation of Criminal Assets Act 2003*, I approve the Confiscated Assets Trust Fund to be used towards activities associated with preventing violence against women and children and promoting safety in the ACT. I approve the funds to be distributed in the following manner and expended by 30 June 2012.
