1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Children and Young People (Childcare Service Licence) Temporary Standards Exemption 2011 (No 33).*

2 Purpose of this Instrument

This instrument is to issue a *Temporary Standards Exemption* as specified in Section 749 (2) of the *Children and Young People Act 2008*.

3 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

4 Expiry

This instrument expires six (6) months after the day it commences.

6 Temporary Standard Exemption Standard

Burgmann After School Care operated by Communities @ Work is exempt from complying with *Children and Young People (ACT Childcare Services) Standards* 2009 (No 1) –

3.3) Positions requiring a qualified person must be filled with an adult holding one of the following qualifications:

<u>Note:</u> These qualifications are in addition to those specified in Core Standard 1.47.

- a) a degree or diploma in education;
- b) a Diploma of Children's Services (Out of School Hours Care) or equivalent;
- c) a Diploma of Youth Work;
- d) a person who has completed the third year of a Bachelor of Education and who is eligible for an internship with the ACT Department of Education;
- e) a Diploma of Leisure and Health;
- f) a Graduate Certificate in Childcare Management;
- g) an Advanced Diploma of Children's Services; or
- h) recognised overseas equivalent of any of the above qualifications.
- 3.4) The position of the service or camp director / coordinator must be filled by an adult who has attained the age of 21 years, and who holds one of the qualifications listed in School Age Care Specific Standard 3.3.

7 Explanation and Additional Conditions

This exemption is required to allow the service to operate with coordinators who have not yet completed the third year of a Bachelor of Education and who have not yet attained the age of 21 years. At least one staff member working at the program must have attained the age of 21 years.
