**1. Name of instrument**

**STATEMENT OF REASONS**

**DECISION NOT TO PROVISIONALLY REGISTER  
KING GEORGE V MEMORIAL, PARKES  
(Block 1 Section 58 Part)  
IN THE ACT HERITAGE REGISTER**

**Assessment**

The Council has decided not to enter the King George V Memorial, Parkes in the ACT Heritage Register because:

1. The place is located on National Land within the Central National Area, and as such the *Heritage Act 2004* does not have effect;
2. The place's heritage values are recognised and protected in the Commonwealth Heritage List, and the details of the listing are included on the ACT Heritage Database, providing public access to information about the ACT's heritage.

Duplication of listing on the ACT Heritage Register therefore would provide no additional legal protection to the place, nor would it provide additional information to the public about the heritage of the ACT.

The Council has therefore decided not to enter the place in the ACT Heritage Register.
