SCHEDULE 1

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

- 1. The approved provider may only perform the services within the geographical boundaries for the event specified by the approval referred to in Clause 3 of this instrument.
- 2. The approved provider must not transport any person outside the geographical boundaries of an approved event.
- 3. This instrument approves only the staff nominated in the First Aid Australia Pty Ltd application for approval under Section 62 of the *Emergencies Act* 2004.
- 4. Staff of First Aid Australia Pty Ltd who are not notified to the Commissioner in the original application may only provide services after the date of the instrument once approved in writing by the Commissioner.
- 5. The approved provider must provide copies of any updated or renewed insurance documentation if insurance is renewed during the approval period.
- 6. The approved provider must give the Commissioner copies of any clinical or pharmaceutical management guidelines implemented during the approval period.
