The planning and land authority, within the Environment and Sustainable Development Directorate (ESDD), is making available for public inspection Draft Variation No 324, including the related documents listed below, which has been given to the Minister for approval:

- background papers
- a report on consultation, including:
 - a written report setting out the issues raised in any written comments (including consultation comments) about the variation
 - a written report about the Authority's consultation with the public, the National Capital Authority, the Conservator of Flora and Fauna, the Environment Protection Authority, the Heritage Council and the land custodian, being the Territory and Municipal Services Directorate

The draft variation was prepared to rezone an area of land comprising approximately 7.8ha in Pialligo, District of Majura on the Western side of Majura Road, opposite Majura Park, from broadacre (NUZ1) to mixed use industrial (IZ2). The variation was prepared in conjunction with the National Capital Authority's draft rezoning of the subject land from 'broadacre' to 'urban' on the National Capital Plan. The rezoning will enable opportunities for large bulky goods retailing, freight transport, warehousing and distribution operations.

Effect of the draft variation
