1 Name of instrument

STATEMENT OF REASONS

DECISION NOT TO PROVISIONALLY REGISTER

Aboriginal Tent Embassy

(Block 1 Section 58, PARKES)

IN THE ACT HERITAGE REGISTER

In accordance with Section 32 of the *Heritage Act 2004*, the ACT Heritage Council has decided not to provisionally register the Aboriginal Tent Embassy, Parkes.

Assessment

The Council has decided not to enter the Aboriginal Tent Embassy, Parkes, in the ACT Heritage Register because:

- The place is located on National Land in a Designated Area, and as such the *Heritage Act 2004* does not have direct effect;
- The place's heritage values are recognised and protected in the Commonwealth Heritage List (Place ID.105466), and the details of any listing are included on the ACT Heritage Database, providing public access to information about the ACT's heritage.

Duplication of listing on the ACT Heritage Register therefore would provide no additional legal protection to the place, nor would it provide additional information to the public about the heritage of the ACT.

Conclusion

Council has therefore decided not to enter the place in the ACT Heritage Register.

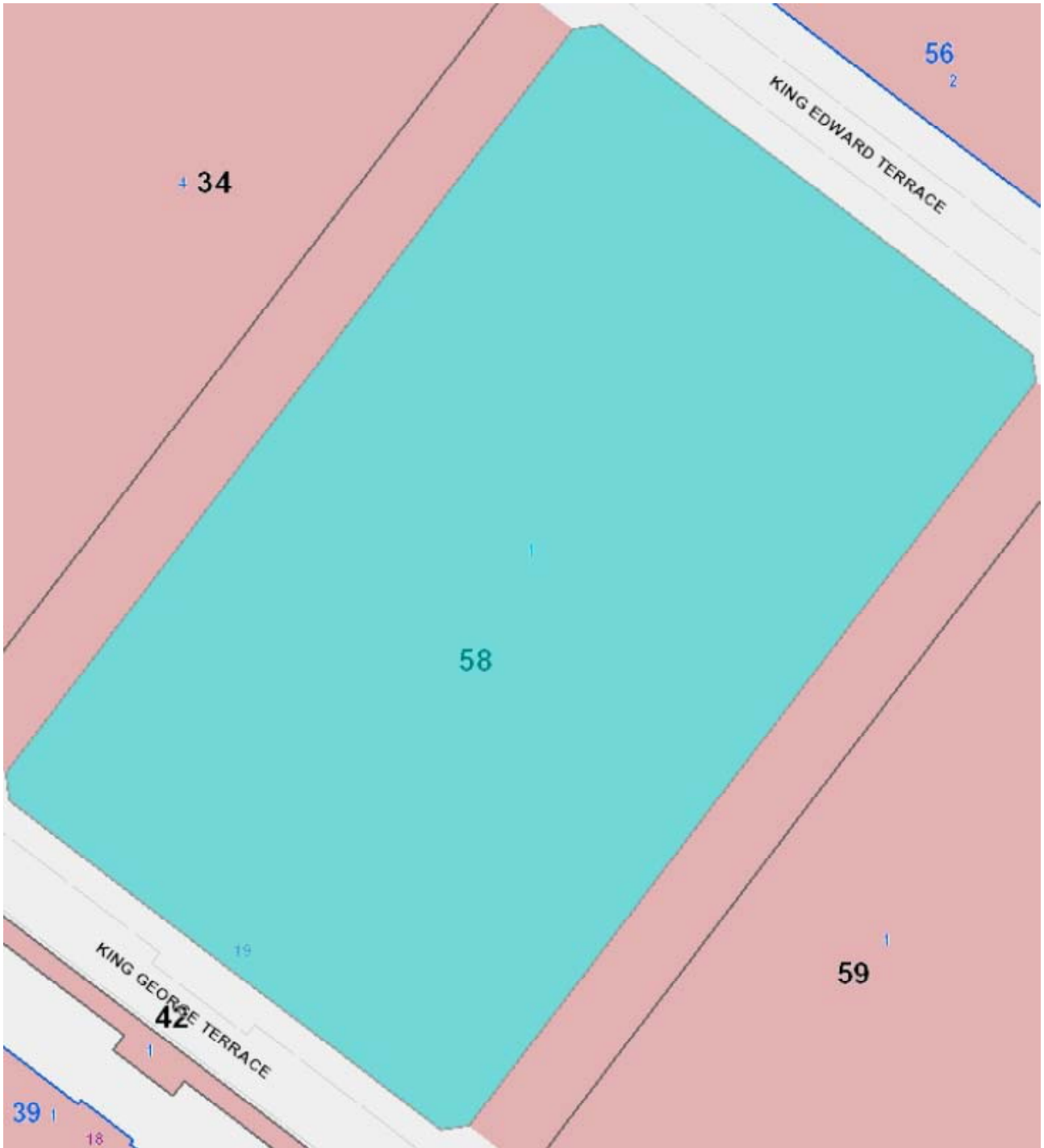


Image 1 Site Boundary, Aboriginal Tent Embassy
