

Public Pools (Operational Matters – Supervision of a Child) Determination 2015 (No 1)

Notifiable Instrument NI2015-324

made under the

Public Pools Act 2015, section 14 (Operational matters)

1 Name of Instrument

This instrument is the *Public Pools (Operational Matters – Supervision of a Child) Determination 2015 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 1 July 2015.

3 Determination

I determine that the following minimum standards apply to the supervision of a child by an accompanying adult within a pool facility:

- a. children under the **minimum age** are not allowed entry unless accompanied by an adult;
- b. children aged between 0 to 5 years and non-swimmers:
 - i. must at all times be accompanied by an adult in the water; and
 - ii. the adult must be within arms' reach of the child or non-swimmer; and
- c. children aged 6 to 12 years:
 - i. must be actively supervised by an adult; and
 - ii. the adult must be prepared to enter the water.

4 Definition

Minimum age means the age prescribed by the Notifiable Instrument for the *Standards for Conditions of Entry and Removal* under section 15 of the *Public Pools Act 2015*.
