1. Name of Instrument

This instrument is the *Heritage (Heritage Council) Delegation 2015 (No. 1)*.

2. Commencement

3. Delegation of functions under the *Planning and Development Act 2007*

The Heritage Council delegates the functions of the Council under the provisions of the *Planning and Development Act 2007* (the P & D Act) identified in column 2 of Schedule B to the person who from time to time occupies the position of Director-General of the Directorate with administrative responsibility for the Act.

4. Revocation

The *Heritage (Heritage Council) Delegation 2014 (No 1)* NI2014-480 made on 2 October 2014 is revoked.
