

# Nature Conservation (Kambah Pool Recreation Area) Activities Declaration 2015 (No 2)

Notifiable instrument NI2015–507

made under the

Nature Conservation Act 2014, s256 (Conservator may make activities declarations)

## 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Nature Conservation (Kambah Pool Recreation Area) Activities Declaration 2015 (No2)*.

## 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

## 3 Application

This instrument applies to the area outlined in bold and shown as “Reserve” in the map in schedule 1 as the Kambah Pool Recreation Area (Kambah Pool Recreation Area).

## 4 Declaration

I declare that in the Kambah Pool Recreation Area:

- the activities listed in column 1 of schedule 2 are prohibited activities; and
- the activities listed in column 2 of schedule 2 are restricted activities and may only be carried out if the requirements identified in Column 2 of schedule 2 for the relevant activity are complied with.

### Example - prohibited activity

The activity of “camping” is a prohibited activity in the Kambah Pool Recreation Area as this activity is listed in column 1 of schedule 2. This means that camping cannot be carried out in the Kambah Pool Recreation Area under any circumstances.

### **Example – restricted activity**

The activity of riding a mountain bike is a restricted activity in the Kambah Pool Recreation Area as this activity is listed in column 2 of schedule 2. This means that the activity of riding a mountain bike cannot be carried out in the Kambah Pool Recreation Area unless it is done in a way that meets the required conditions. In this case, the required conditions are that the riding of a bike must be on the Centenary Trail identified on the map at Schedule 1; and other formed trails unless signposted otherwise.

*Note 1:* Under section 256 of the *Nature Conservation Act 2014* (the Act) the Conservator may declare activities in a reserve to be a restricted or prohibited activity if the conservator reasonably believes that a certain activity, if carried out in a reserve, may have a negative impact on the reserve.

*Note 2:* Under section 169(1)(b) of the Act the area in the Kambah Pool Recreation Area is a “reserve” for the purposes of the Act because the area is both:

- a) public land reserved in the Territory Plan as a Special Purpose Reserve under section 315(d) of the *Planning and Development Act 2007*; and
- b) prescribed by section 5 of the *Nature Conservation Regulation 2015* as a reserve.

## **5 Revocation**

The *Nature Conservation (Kambah Pool Recreation Area) Activities Declaration 2015 (No 1)* (NI2015–413) is revoked.
