

Supreme Court (Court of Appeal President Salary) Determination 2016 (No 2)

Notifiable instrument NI2016–246

made under the

Supreme Court Act 1933, section 37U (Resident judges)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Supreme Court (Court of Appeal President Salary) Determination 2016 (No 2)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument is taken to have commenced on 25 September 2015.

3 Determination

I determine the appropriate current judicial salary applicable to a person appointed as Court of Appeal President under the *Supreme Court Act 1933* prior to 21 April 2015 to be:

- a) the same remuneration, allowances and entitlements a judge of the Supreme Court is entitled to from time to time under section 37U(2) of the *Supreme Court Act 1933*; and
- b) an additional allowance equivalent to 9.5 per cent of the remuneration, allowances and entitlements a judge of the Supreme Court is entitled to from time to time under section 37U(2) of the *Supreme Court Act 1933*.

This determination is non-prejudicial.

Note: Section 76(1) of the *Legislation Act 2001* provides that a statutory instrument may provide that a non-prejudicial provision of an instrument commences retrospectively.

4. Revocation

This instrument revokes the *Supreme Court (Court of Appeal President Salary) Determination 2016 (No 1)* NI2016-25.
