1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Nature Conservation Threatened Native Species List 2016 (No 1).*

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

3 Minor amendments to List of threatened species

Under section 94 of the *Nature Conservation Act 2014* (the Act), I prepare a new threatened native species list (new list), incorporating the minor amendments into the existing threatened native species list, and prepare a final version of the new list, as set out in the schedule.

existing threatened native species list means the *Nature Conservation Threatened Native Species List 2015 (No 1)* NI2015–438.

Note 1: Section 94 of the Act provides that the Minister may prepare a new list if the Minister considers that a minor amendment to a list is appropriate. In this case, the Minister need not comply with the requirements of ss 84 to 92 of the Act.

Note 2: Section 93 of the Act defines a *minor amendment* to include updating the name of a threatened native species. This amendment updates the scientific name of the Scarlet Robin from *Petroica multicolor* to *Petroica boodang*. The scientific name of the Regent Honeyeater is also updated from *Xanthomyza phrygia* to *Anthochaera phrygia*. These updates reflect the naming used in the Australian Faunal Directory (ABRS 2009. *Australian Faunal Directory*. Australian Biological Resources Study, Canberra. Viewed 07 April 2016. http://www.environment.gov.au/biodiversity/abrs/online-resources/fauna/afd/index.html).

Note 3: Section 91 of the Act provides that the final version of a threatened native species list is a notifiable instrument.

4 Revocation
