

# Planning and Development (Draft Variations No 344 and No 345) Public Consultation Extension Notice 2017

## 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Planning and Development (Draft Variations No 344 and No 345) Public Consultation Extension Notice 2017*.

## 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

## 3 Extension of public consultation periods

The public consultation periods for draft plan variation No 344 – Woden town centre and draft plan variation No 345 – Mawson group centre (**the Draft Variations**) are extended until 2 June 2017.

*Note 1* The public consultation period for draft plan variation No 344 – Woden town centre was previously determined by the *Planning and Development (Draft Variation No 344) Consultation Notice 2017* (NI2017-106). Under NI2017-106, the consultation period was due to end on 21 April 2017. *Note 2* The public consultation period for draft plan variation No 345 – Mawson group centre was previously determined by the *Planning and Development (Draft Variation No 345) Consultation Notice 2017* (NI2017-107). Under NI2017-107, the consultation period was due to end on 21 April 2017. *Note 3* Under s 63(2) of the *Planning and Development Act 2007*, the planning and land authority may, by notice, extend or further extend the consultation period. An extension notice is a notifiable instrument.
