1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Emergencies (Service Provider) Approval 2017 (No 2)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 24 May 2017.

3 Approval

I approve MOTORSPORT SAFETY AND RESCUE PTY LTD (the approved provider) to provide ambulance services (the services) at events in the ACT.

4 Conditions on Approval

Approval is subject to the conditions contained in Schedule 1.

5 Expiry

This instrument expires on 23 May 2018.

SCHEDULE 1

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

1. The approved provider may only perform the services within the geographical boundaries and timeframe of an approved event notified to and approved by the Chief Officer ACT Ambulance Service.
2. The approved provider must not transport any person outside the geographical boundaries of event notified to the Chief Officer, ACT Ambulance Service.
3. This instrument approves only the staff nominated in the approved provider's application for approval under Section 61 of the *Emergencies Act 2004*.
4. Staff of the approved provider who are not nominated in the application for approval may only provide the services with the Chief Officer ACT Ambulance Service's prior written approval.
5. The approved provider must provide copies of any updated or renewed insurance documentation to the Chief Officer ACT Ambulance Service if insurance is renewed or varied before this instrument expires.
6. The approved provider must provide the Chief Officer ACT Ambulance Service copies of any clinical or pharmaceutical management guidelines implemented during the approval period.
