Nature Conservation (Sherwood Forest Special Purpose Reserve) Activities Declaration 2017

Notifiable instrument NI2017-366

made under the

Nature Conservation Act 2014, s 256 (Conservator may make activities declarations)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Nature Conservation (Sherwood Forest Special Purpose Reserve) Activities Declaration 2017.*

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

3 Application

This instrument applies to part of the Sherwood Forest Special Purpose Reserve (**the Relevant Area**). The Relevant Area of the Sherwood Forest Special Purpose Reserve is the area shown on the map in schedule 1 as "Special Purpose Reserve" except for the hatched area shown as "Rural Lease in Reserve".

Note Under section 169 of the Nature Conservation Act 2014 (the Act) the area of Sherwood Forest Special Purpose Reserve is a 'reserve' for the purposes of the Act because the area includes public land reserved in the Territory Plan as a Special Purpose Reserve under section 315 (d) of the Planning and Development Act 2007.

4 Declaration

I declare that in the Relevant Area of the Sherwood Forest Special Purpose Reserve—

- (a) an activity listed in column 1 of schedule 2 is prohibited; and
- (b) an activity listed in column 2 of schedule 2 is restricted and may only be carried out if the stated directions or requirements are complied with.
- Note 1 If an activity is a 'prohibited activity' it means the activity cannot be carried out in any circumstance in the reserve. For example 'camping' is declared to be a prohibited activity. This means that camping cannot be carried out in the Relevant Area of the Sherwood Forest Special Purpose Reserve under any circumstances.

- Note 2 If an activity is a 'restricted activity' it means that it may only be carried out in the reserve if the stated directions or requirements are complied with. For example, the 'use of non-motorised vehicles including bicycles' is declared to be a restricted activity. This means the use of non-motorised vehicles, including bicycles, cannot be carried out in the Relevant Area of the Sherwood Forest Special Purpose Reserve unless it is done in a way that meets the stated requirements.
- Note 3 The Act includes general offences which apply to all reserves (including Sherwood Forest Special Purpose Reserve). The Act may be found at http://www.legislation.act.gov.au/a/2014-59/default.asp.

5 Revocation

This instrument revokes the *Nature Conservation (Sherwood Forest Special Purpose Reserve) Activities Declaration 2016* (NI2016-571).

6 Definitions

In this instrument—

Equestrian activity means riding or leading an equine.


Equine means a horse, donkey, mule or hinny.
