Planning and Development (Environmental Impact Statement – Removal and Replacement of Underground Storage Tanks – Block 50 Section 18 Mitchell) Exemption 2017

Notifiable instrument NI2017–387

Planning and Development Act 2007, s 211H (EIS exemption – decision)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Planning and Development (Environmental Impact Statement – Removal and Replacement of Underground Storage Tanks - Block 50 Section 18 Mitchell) Exemption 2017*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

3 Grant

In accordance with section 211H of the *Planning and Development Act 2007* (the Act), I grant an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) Exemption for the removal and replacement of underground storage tanks from Block 50 Section 18 Mitchell.

Note 1 Under s 211H of the Act, the Minister may grant an EIS exemption if satisfied that the expected environmental impact of the development proposal has already been sufficiently addressed by a recent study.
