1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Environment Protection (Draft Contaminated Sites Environment Protection Policy) Notice 2017.*

2 Commencement

Brief Description of Draft Policy

The Draft Contaminated Sites **Environment Protection Policy** contains information and policies relating to the assessment, remediation (including management) and audit of contaminated land and aims to minimise the risk of adverse impacts of contaminated land on the environment and human health. The draft policy explains the procedures used by the EPA to regulate the management of contaminated land within the ACT and provides guidance for owners and occupiers of contaminated land to meet their legislative obligations under the Act.
