1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Planning and Development (Environmental Impact Statement – Mixed Use Development – Blocks 2 and 3 Section 67 Kingston) Exemption 2018.*

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

3 Grant

In accordance with section 211H of the *Planning and Development Act 2007* (the Act), I grant an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) exemption for the construction of a mixed use development on Blocks 2 and 3 Section 67 Kingston.

- *Note 1* Under s 211H of the Act, the Minister may grant an EIS exemption if satisfied that the expected environmental impact of the development proposal has already been sufficiently addressed by a recent study.
