

Planning and Development (Draft Variation No 359) Public Availability Notice 2018

Notifiable instrument NI2018—664

made under the

Planning and Development Act 2007, s 70 (Public notice of documents given to Minister) and section 71 (Public availability notice—notice of interim effect etc)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Planning and Development (Draft Variation No 359) Public Availability Notice 2018*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

3 Documents available for public inspection

- (1) The planning and land authority (the **Authority**) gives notice that the following documents are available for public inspection:
 - (a) Draft Plan Variation to the Territory Plan No359 – Changes to the Tharwa Precinct Map and Code and removal of public land overlay (the **Draft Variation**);
 - (b) a written report setting out the issues raised in any consultation comments about the Draft Variation;
 - (c) a written report about the Authority's consultation with the public, the National Capital Authority (**NCA**), the Conservator of Flora and Fauna, the Environment Protection Authority, the Heritage Council and the land custodian; and
 - (d) a copy of any written document given to the Minister by the NCA in relation to the Draft Variation.
- (2) Copies of the documents mentioned in section 2(1) are available for inspection at Access Canberra, Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Shopfront, Ground Floor South, Dame Pattie Menzies House, 16 Challis Street, Dickson, Monday to Friday (except public holidays) between 8:30am and 4:30pm for a period of six-months ending on the day this instrument expires.

4 Effect of the draft plan variation

Section 72 of the *Planning and Development Act 2007* (the **Act**) does not apply in relation to the Draft Variation and therefore the Draft Variation does not have interim effect. The current Territory Plan will continue to apply while the Draft Variation remains in draft form.
