

# Planning and Development (Environmental Impact Statement – Molonglo 132kV Transmission Line Relocation) Exemption 2021

## 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Planning and Development (Environmental Impact Statement – Molonglo 132kV Transmission Line Relocation) Exemption 2021*.

## 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

## 3 Grant

In accordance with section 211H of the *Planning and Development Act 2007* (the Act), I grant an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) exemption for the Molonglo 132kV Transmission Line Relocation proposal.

*Note 1* Under s 211H of the Act, the Minister may grant an EIS exemption if satisfied that the expected environmental impact of the development proposal has already been sufficiently addressed by a recent study.

#### **4 EIS exemption—expiry**

- (b) if a later day is prescribed by regulation—the later day.
