#### 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Utilities* (Energy industry levy – base amount) Determination 2022.

## 2 Determination – of the base amount for an energy industry sector

I determine that the base amount (B) set out in section 54C of the *Utilities Act* 2000 to be applied to each energy industry sector for the levy determination years 2022–23 to 2026–27 is as follows:

## 3 Base amount – explanation

The base amount (B in the energy industry levy formula) represents the minimum marginal cost of regulating a utility in the sector regardless of how much energy it might sell. This cost is essentially the base cost of administering the energy industry levy for each utility in the sector.
