1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Water Resources (Environment Protection Authority) Delegation 2022*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

3 Delegation of the Environment Protection Authority's functions

I delegate the functions of the Environment Protection Authority under the provisions of the *Water Resources Act 2007* identified in column 1 of the schedule to the position/s listed in Column 3.

Note 1: The *Legislation Act 2001* defines 'occupy a position' to include hold the position, act in the position or exercise the functions of the position.

Note 2: The Environment Protection Authority will continue to exercise delegated functions as necessary – Section 240, *Legislation Act 2001*
