1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Liquor* (*Temporary Alcohol-Free Place*) *Declaration* 2022(*No* 2).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences at 7am on 5 January 2023.

3 Declaration

I declare the following locations as temporary alcohol-free areas from 7am on 5 January 2023 to 5pm on 8 January 2023:

- a) The Federal Highway within the Australian Capital Territory;
- b) Northbourne Avenue, north of the southernmost point of its intersection with Macarthur Avenue and Wakefield Avenue;
- c) The hatched area shown on the attached map in Attachment 1 that is within the heavy black line on the map and is a public place.
- d) Any unleased land adjoining a public place mentioned in paragraphs a) to c).

But excluding:

- e) The areas designated for Summernats 35, highlighted by the bold red line on the map at Attachment 2.
- f) licensed premises or permitted premises; or
- g) premises where food is sold for consumption at the premises; or
- h) at a place that is within 50m from premises mentioned in paragraph (f) or (g) by a person using furniture or other facilities provided by the proprietor or lessee of the premises.


