1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Nature Conservation (Closed Reserves) Declaration* 2023 (No 2).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 30 May 2023.

3 Declaration

I declare that public access to the reserves listed in column 1 of schedule 1 (the *closed reserves*) is prohibited during the corresponding closure times in column 2 of schedule 1.

4 Exceptions

Section 3 does not apply to:

- (a) a conservation officer exercising a function under the Act; or
- (b) a person accompanied by a conservation officer exercising a function under the Act; or
- (c) a contractor undertaking rabbit control work within the closed reserves and engaged by the ACT Government to do so.

5 Revocation

The *Nature Conservation (Closed Reserves) Declaration 2023 (No 1)* (NI2023-247) is revoked.

6 Expiry

This instrument expires on 28 July 2023.
