

Liquor (Temporary Alcohol-Free Place) Declaration 2023 (No 2)

Notifiable instrument NI2023-828

made under the

Liquor Act 2010, s 198 (alcohol-free places)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Liquor (Temporary Alcohol-Free Place) Declaration 2023 (No 2)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences at 7am on 4 January 2024.

3 Declaration

I declare the following locations as temporary alcohol-free areas from 7am on 4 January 2024 to 6pm on 7 January 2024:

- a) The Federal Highway;
- b) Northbourne Avenue, north of the southernmost point of its intersection with Macarthur Avenue and Wakefield Avenue;
- c) The hatched area shown on the attached map in Attachment 1 that is within the heavy black line on the map and is a public place; and
- d) Any unleased land adjoining a public place mentioned in paragraphs a) to c).

But excluding:

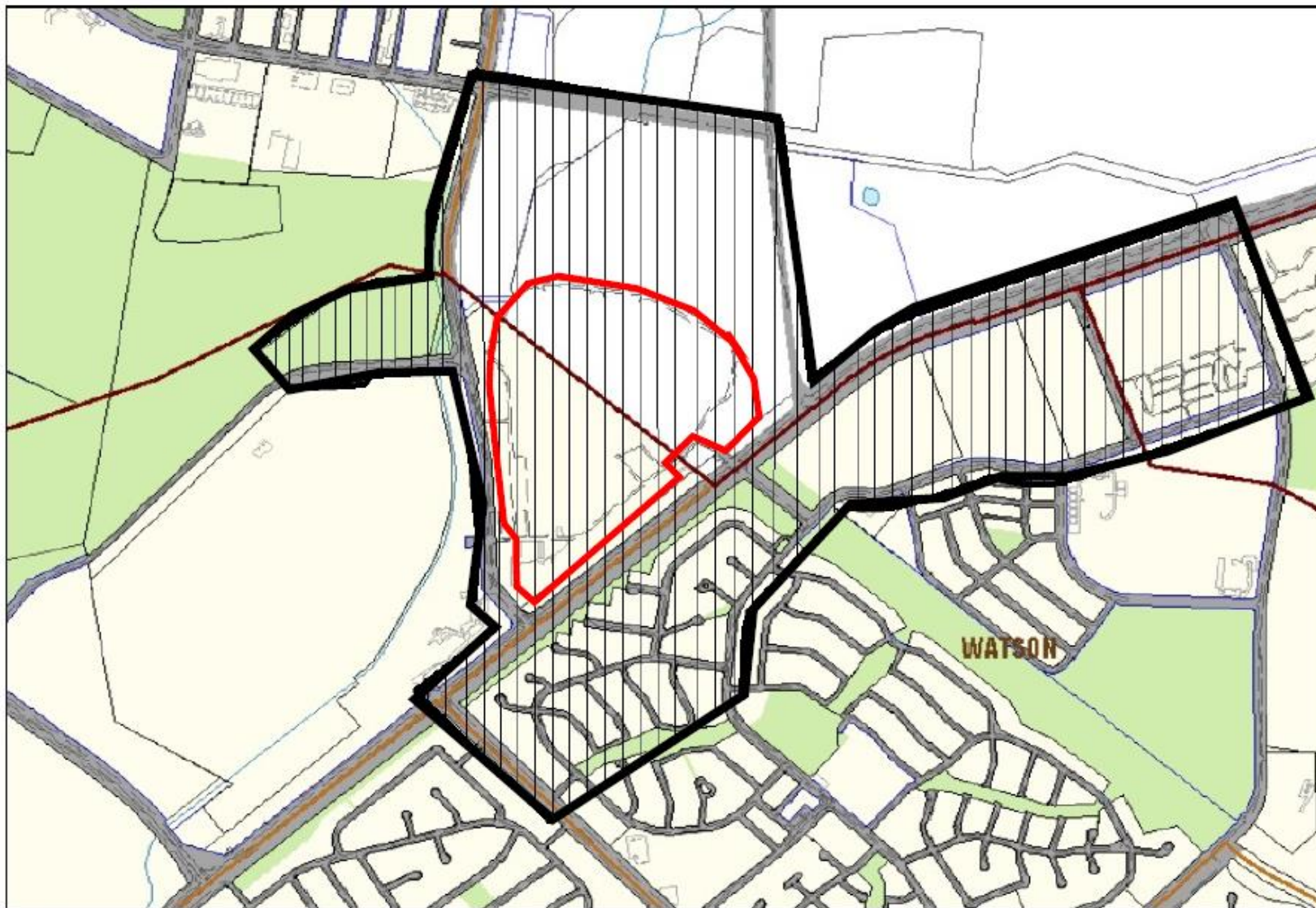
- e) The areas designated for Summernats 35, bound by the bold red line on the map at Attachment 1;
- f) Licensed premises or permitted premises; or
- g) Premises where food is sold for consumption at the premises; or
- h) At a place that is within 50m from premises mentioned in paragraph (f) or (g) by a person using furniture or other facilities provided by the proprietor or lessee of the premises.

4 Expiry

This instrument expires at 6pm on 7 January 2024.
