# Liquor (Special Event) Declaration 2025 (No 3)

Liquor Act 2010, s 214D (Declaration of special event)

### 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Liquor* (Special Event) Declaration 2025 (No 3).

### 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after it is notified.

### 3 Declaration of special event – Act, s 214D (4) (a) (i)

The event specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 is declared to be a special event.

## 4 Date and time of special event – Act, s 214D (4) (a) (ii)

The date and time of the special event is specified in column 2 of Schedule 1.

# Date and extended hours during which a licensee for the licensed premises may supply liquor at the premises for the event – Act, s 214D (4) (a) (iii)

The date and extended hours during which a licensee for a licensed premises may supply liquor at the premises for the special event are specified in column 3 of Schedule 1.

### 6 Conditions – Act, s 214D (4) (b)

Any conditions with which a licensee for the licensed premises must comply for the special event are specified in column 4 of Schedule 1.

### 7 Expiry

This instrument expires on 10 July 2025.

### Schedule 1

# **Special Event Declaration**

Under section 214D (1) of the *Liquor Act 2010* (the Act), the Head of Access Canberra may declare an event to be a *special event*. This provides for extended trading where a licensee may supply liquor at the licensed premises during any extended trading period stated in Column 3.

A licensee must comply with any conditions stated in Column 4.

In making this declaration, the Head of Access Canberra is satisfied that the event stated in Column 1 is a significant event at an international, national, State, Territory or local level, and that it is in the public interest to make this declaration.

Column 1 – special event	Column 2 – date and time of special event	Column 3 – date and extended hours during which a licensee for the licensed premises may supply liquor at the premises for the event	Column 4 - conditions
British and Irish Lions vs ACT Brumbies	Wednesday, 9 July 2025	Extended until 2am, Thursday 10 July 2025	Extended hours apply only to drinks sold for consumption on premises, not off premises sale. Licensees subject to an approved Risk-assessment Management Plan (RAMP) must continue operating under the procedures and risk controls as set out in the RAMP.
